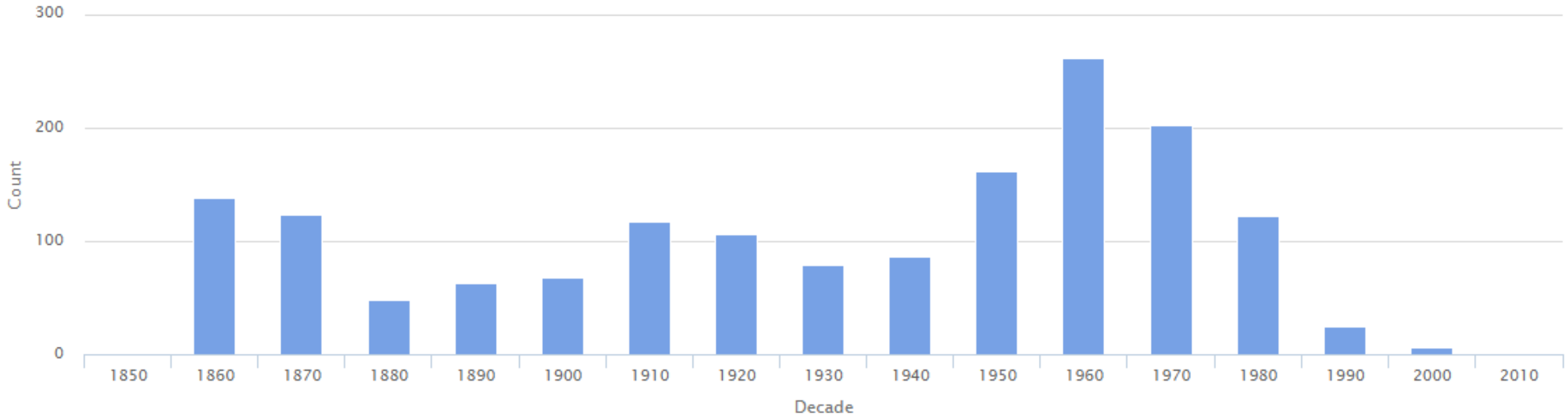

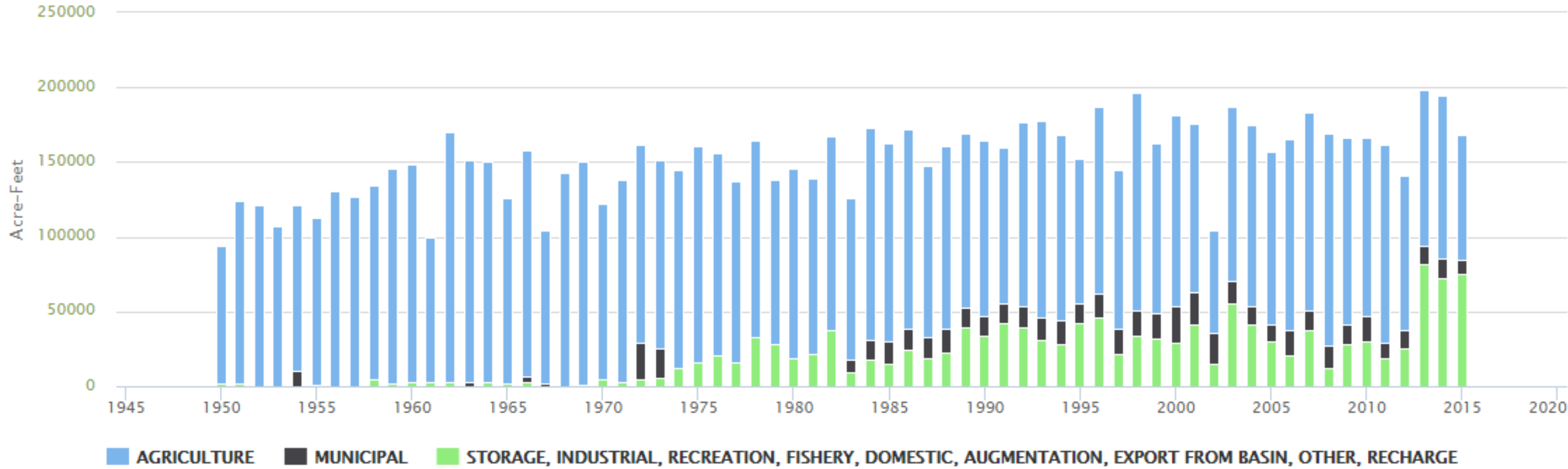
BAD BAR CHART

Count of Water Rights by Year



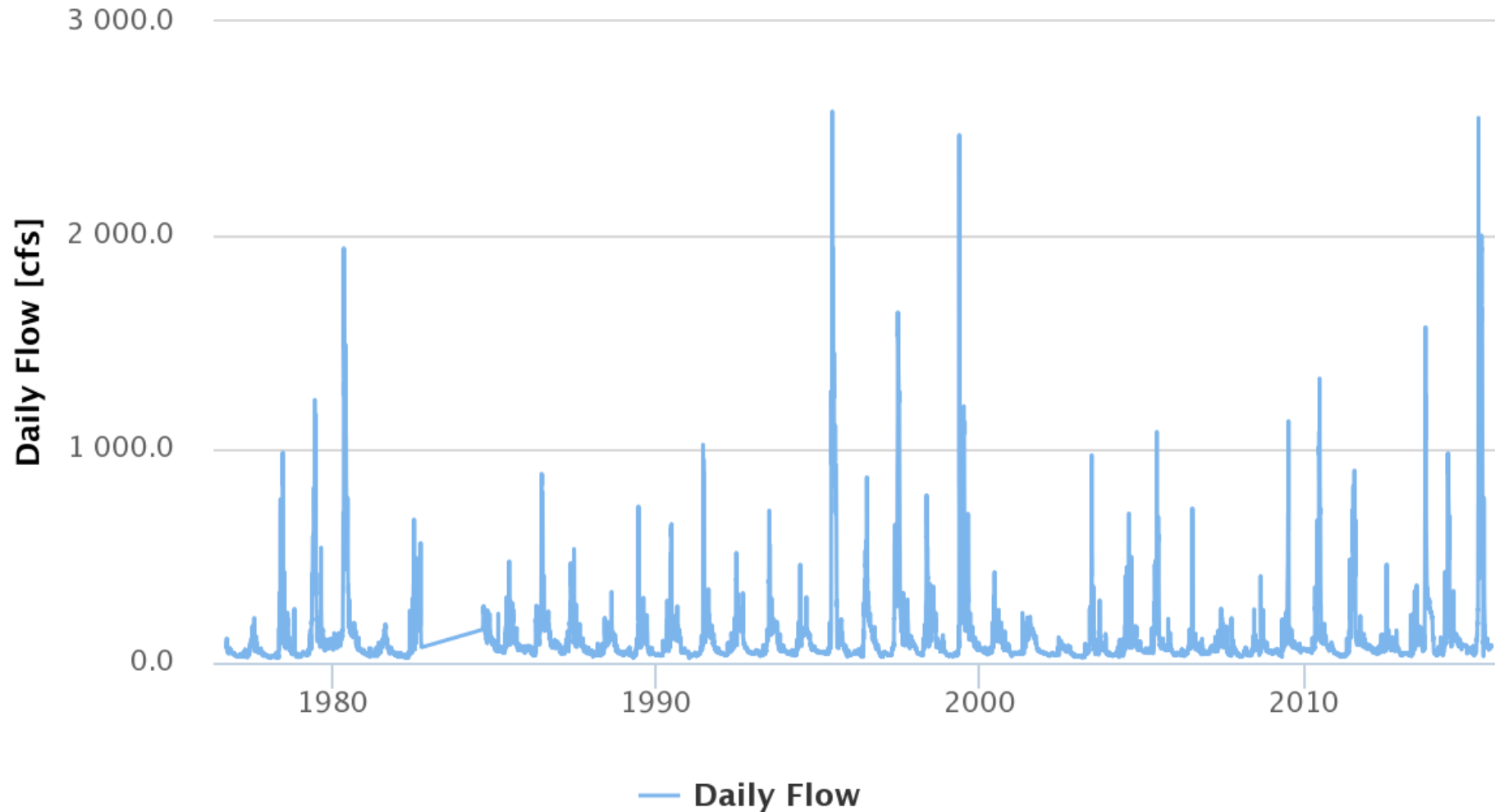
GOOD BAR CHART

Historic Diversion Volume by Year

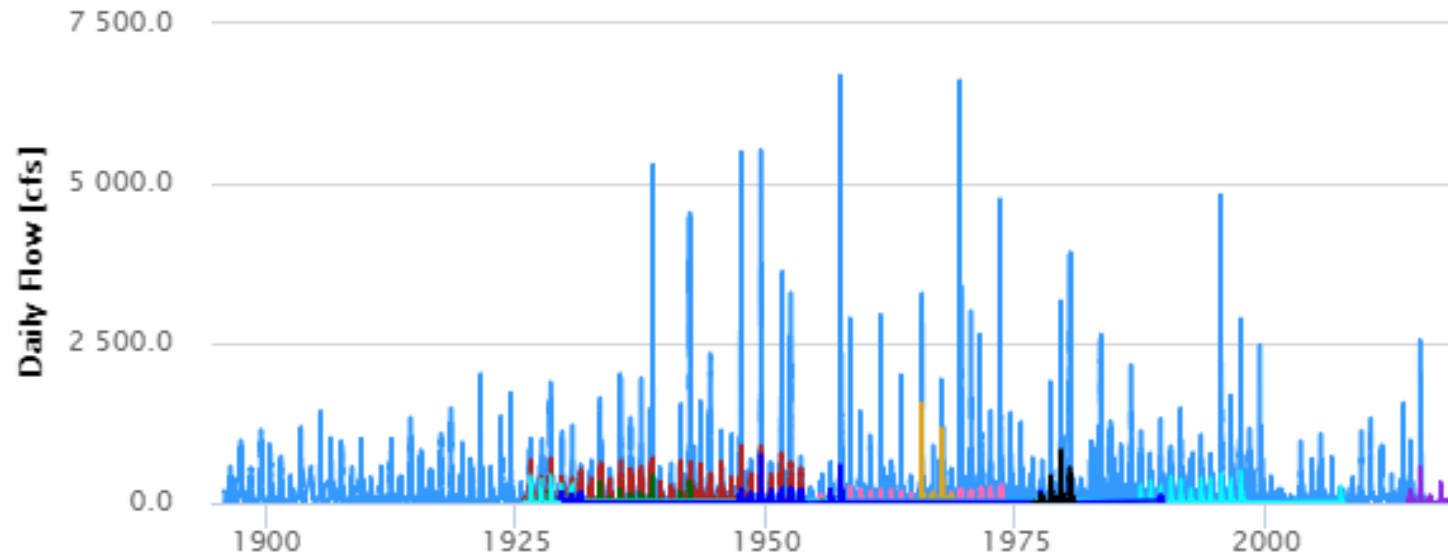

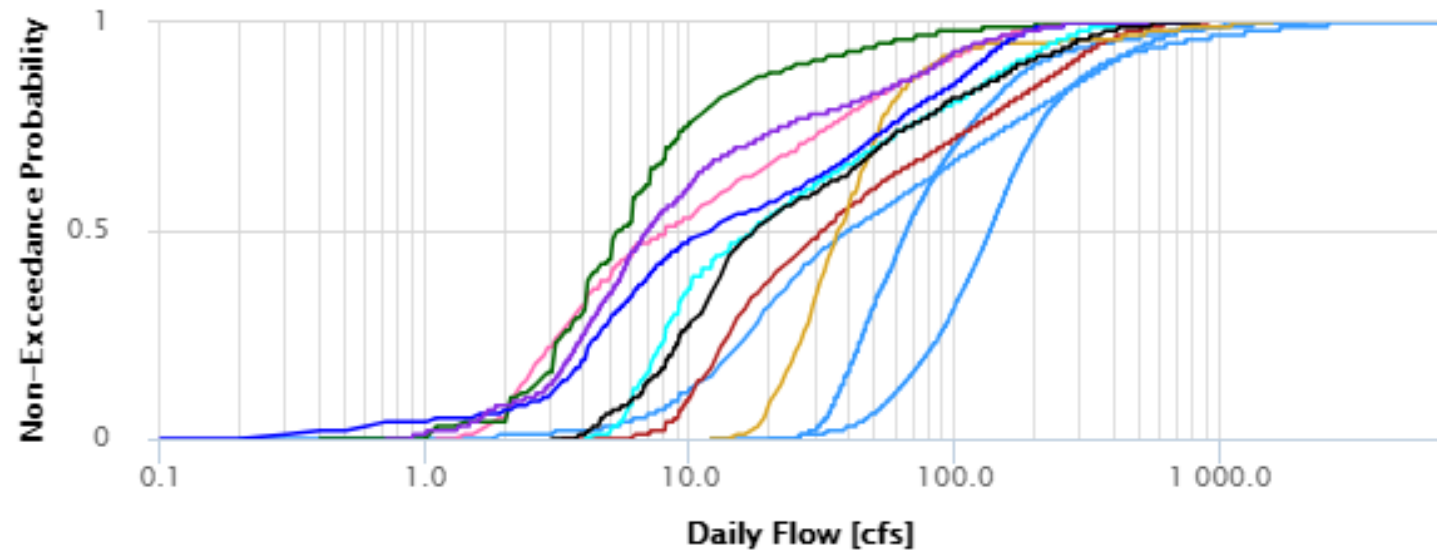

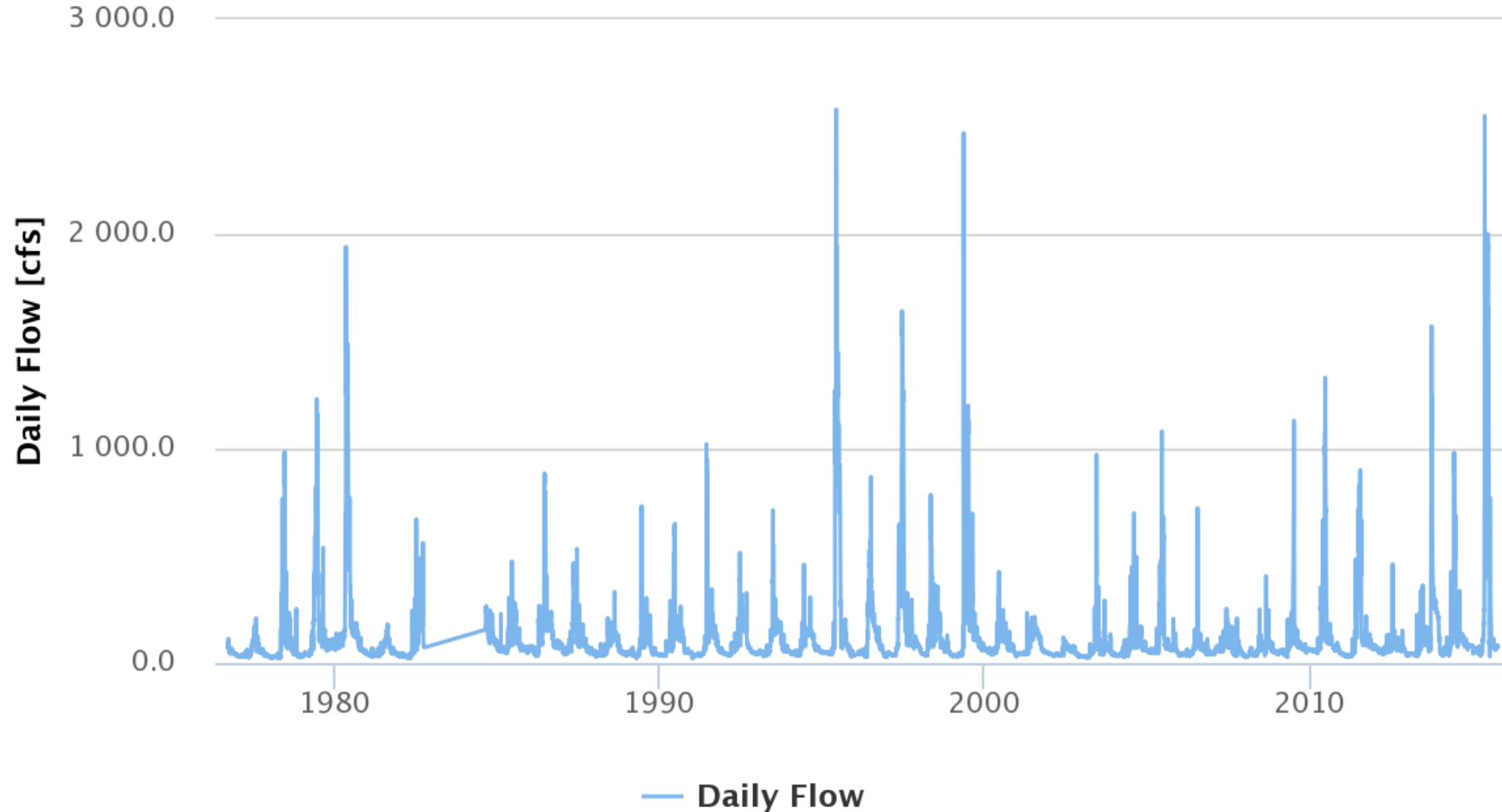

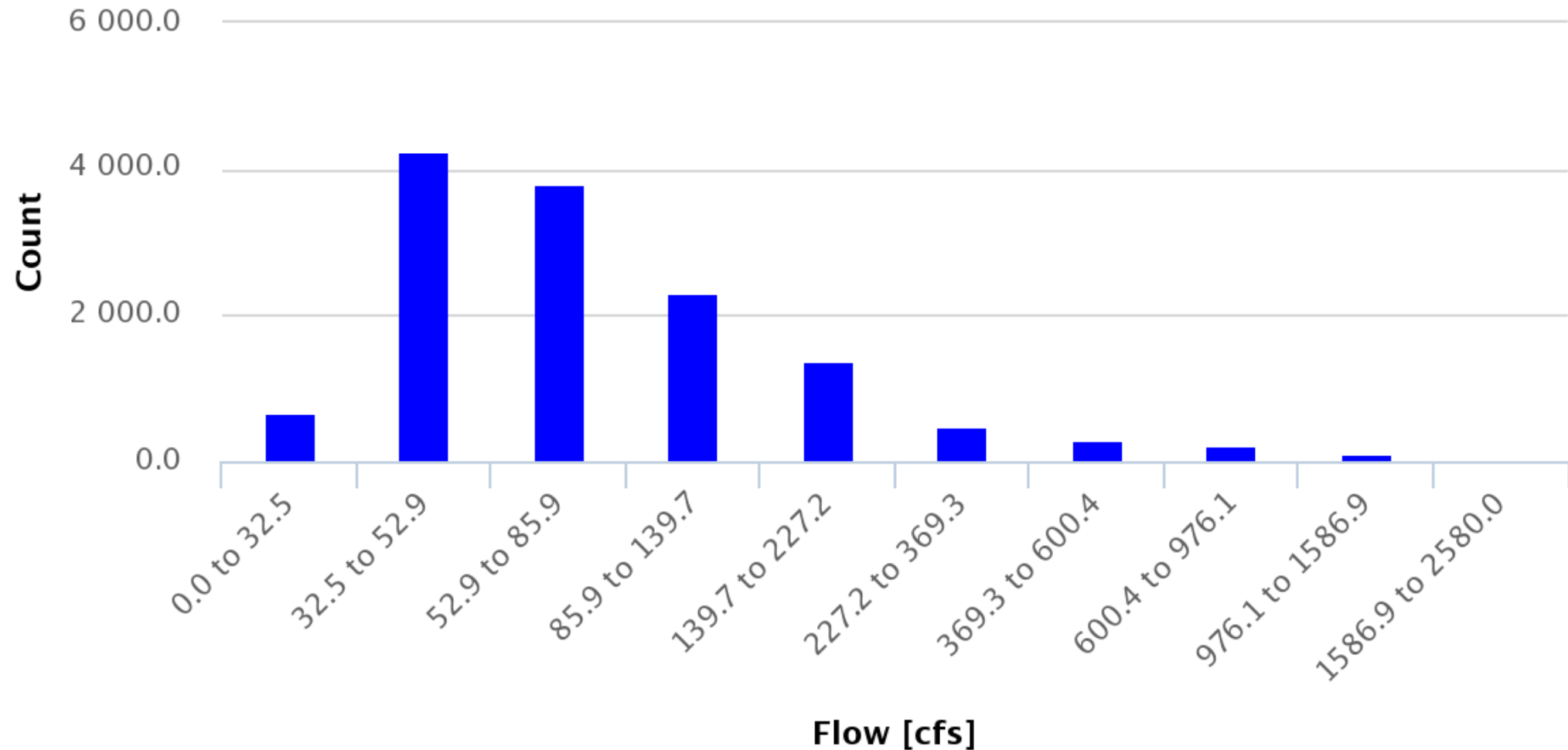

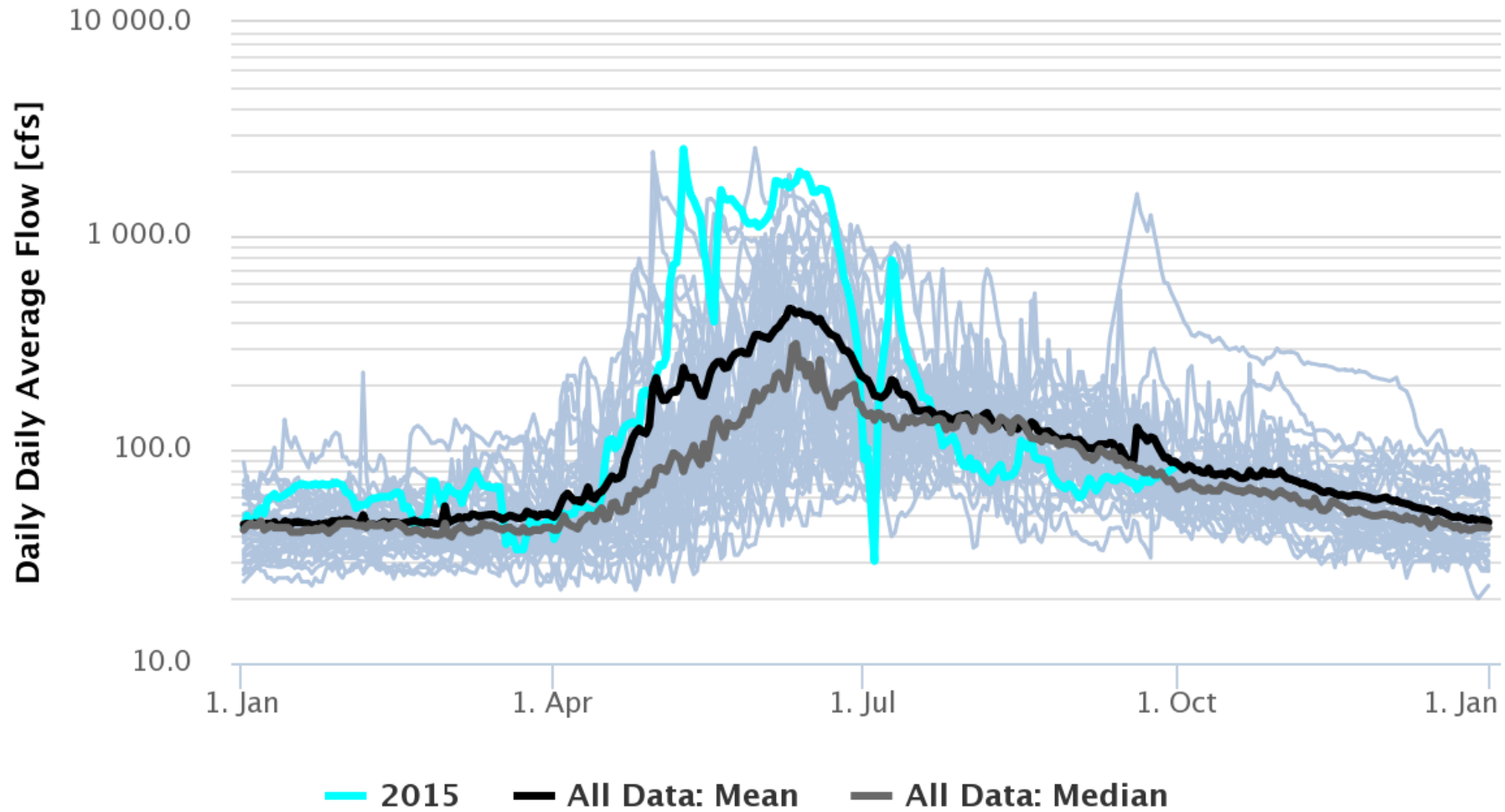
COMPLEX TIME SERIES: HISTOGRAM

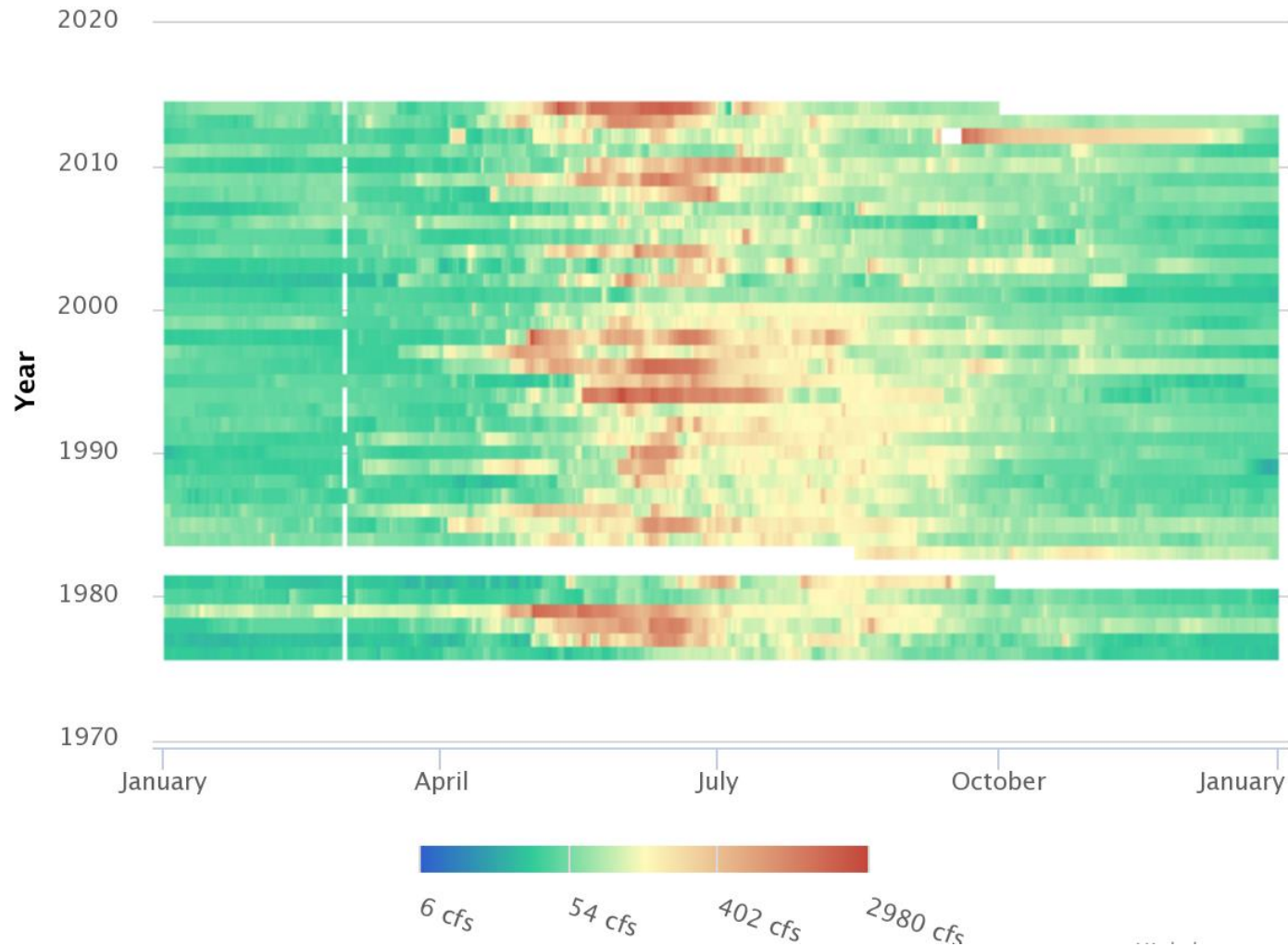
COMPLEX TIME SERIES: ENVELOPE

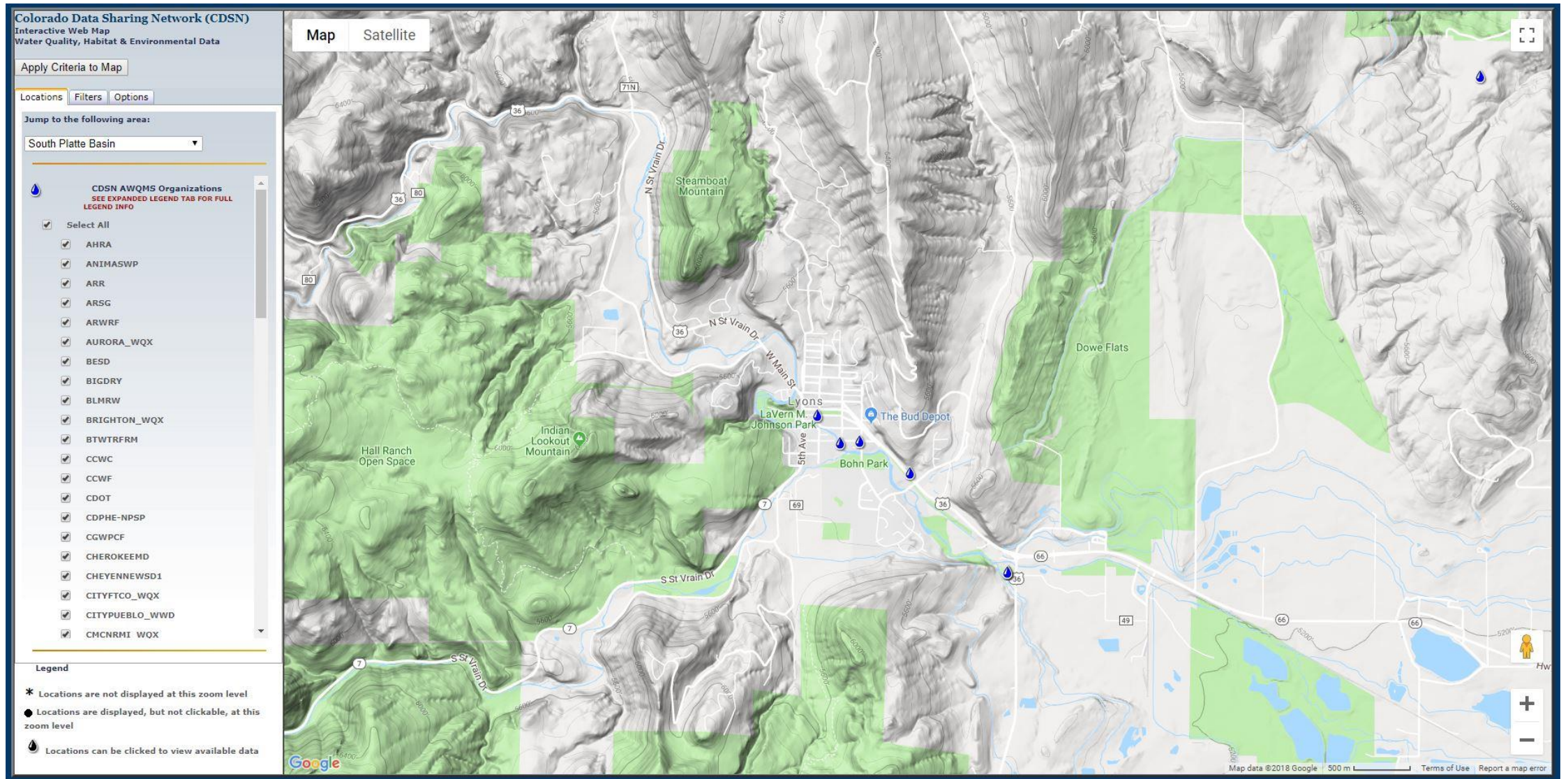

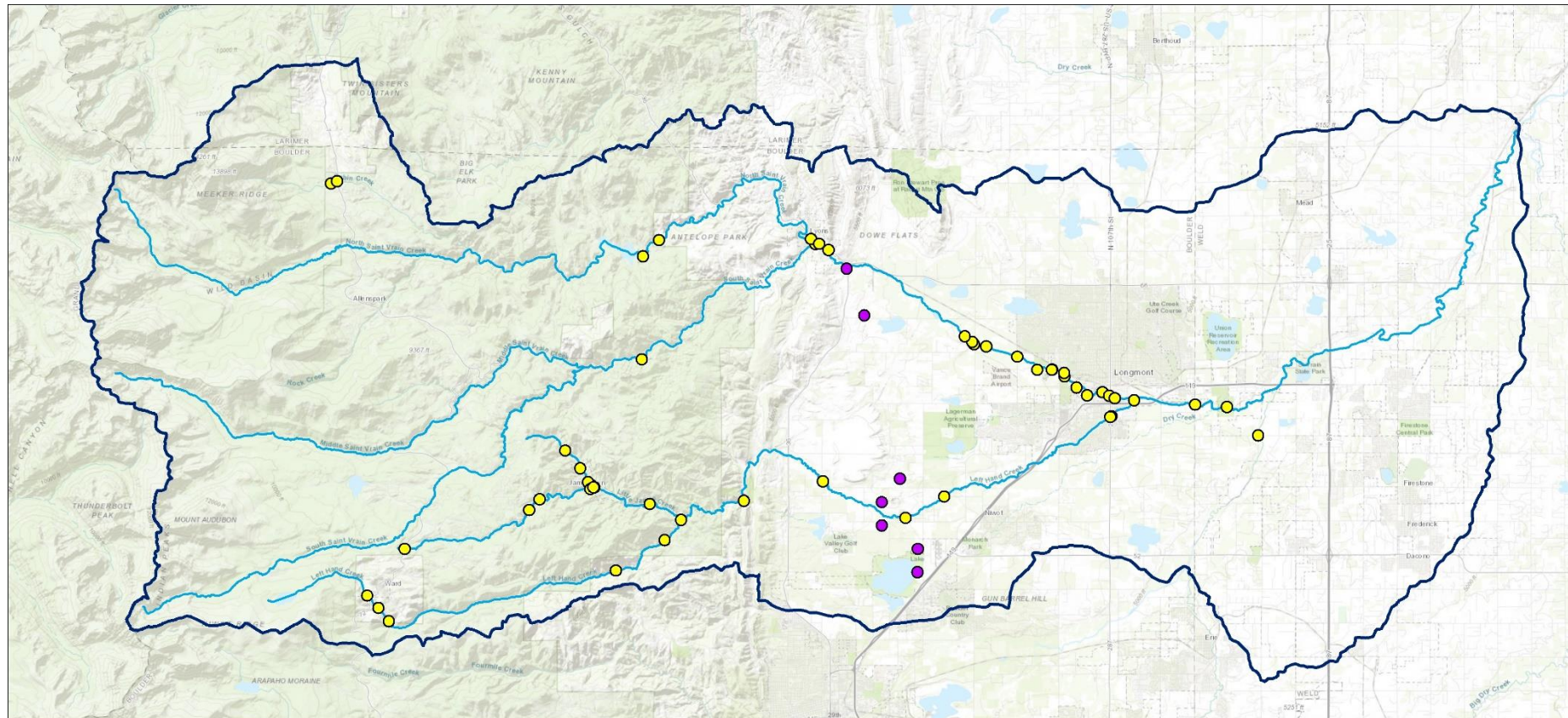

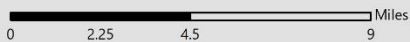

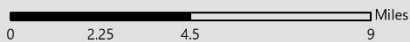

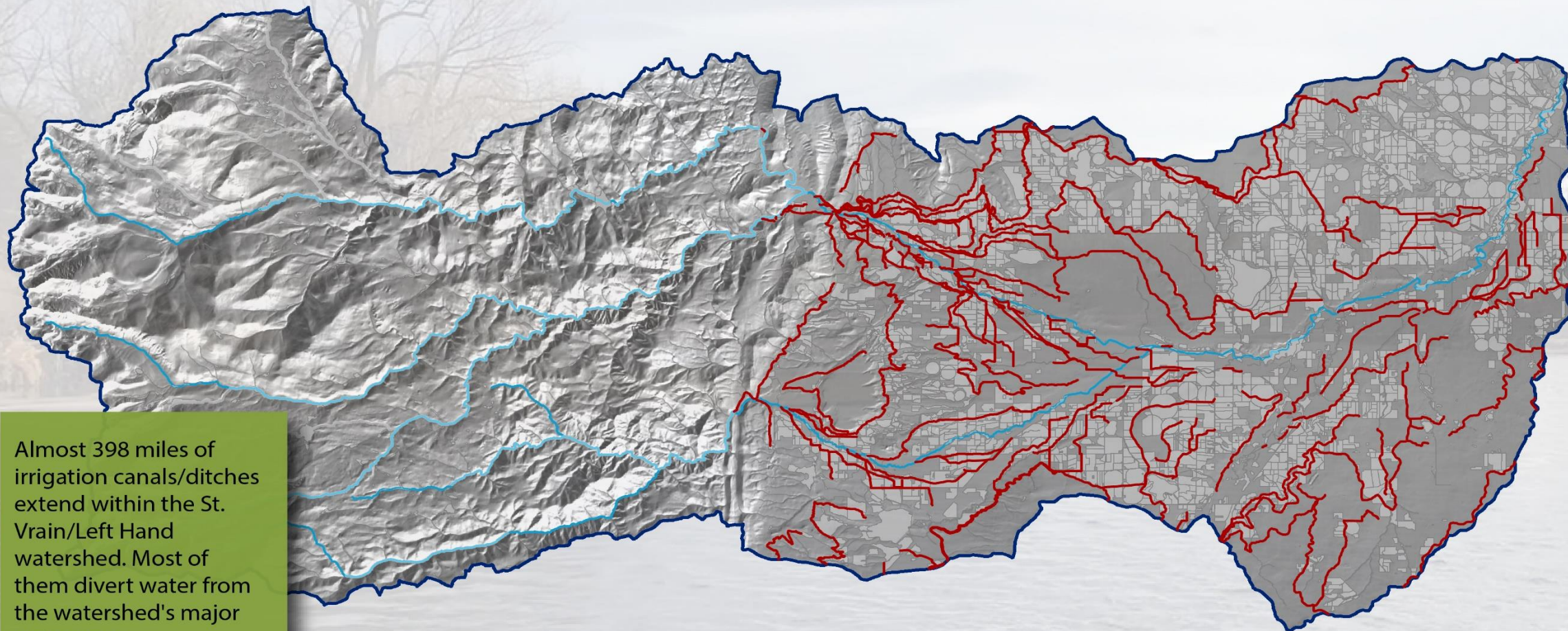


Irrigated Parcels

Irrigation Canals/Ditches



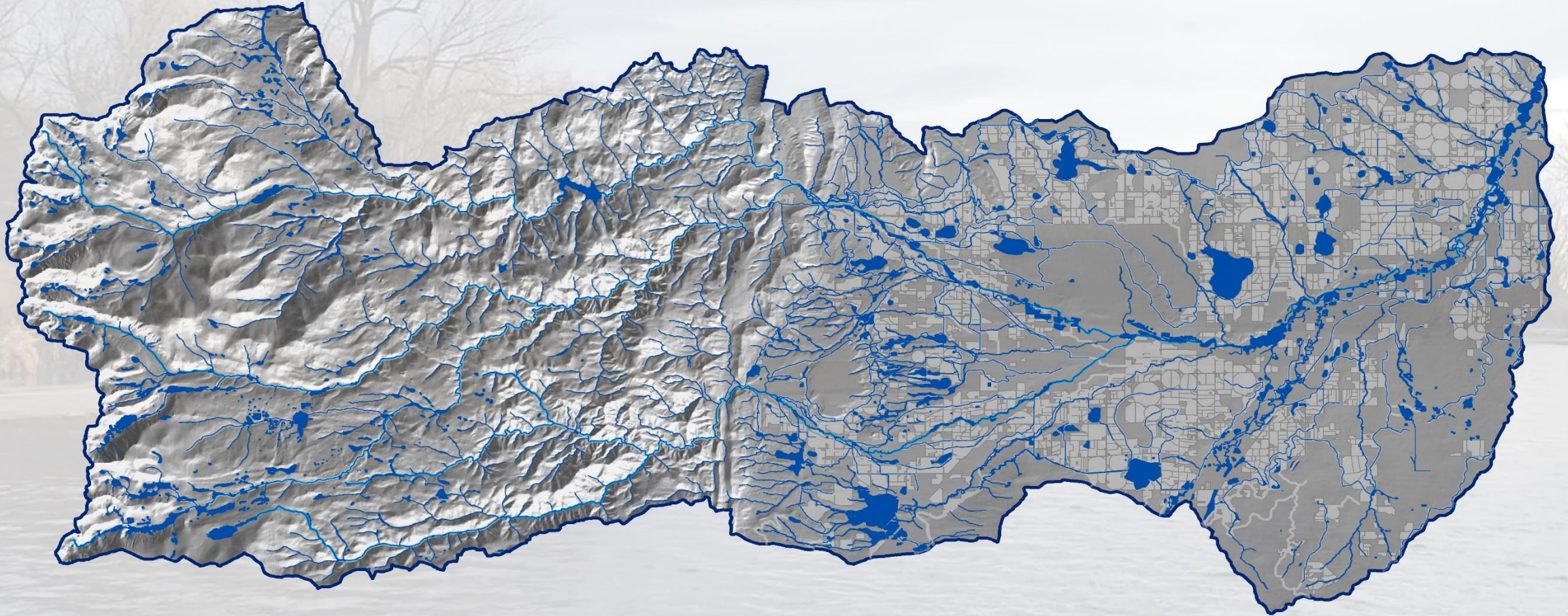
Almost 398 miles of irrigation canals/ditches extend within the St. Vrain/Left Hand watershed. Most of them divert water from the watershed's major waterways.

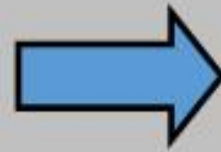

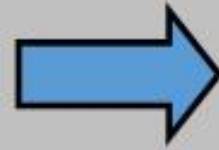

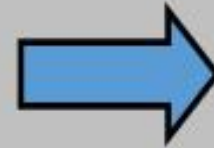


Depends on healthy stream flow so that the rancher can irrigate the crops that will be consumed either raw or cooked in either the home, restaurant, picnic, or other

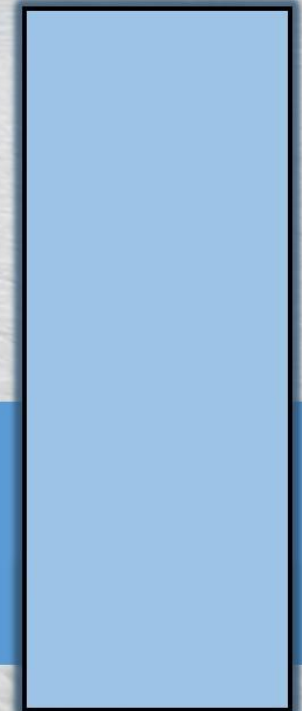
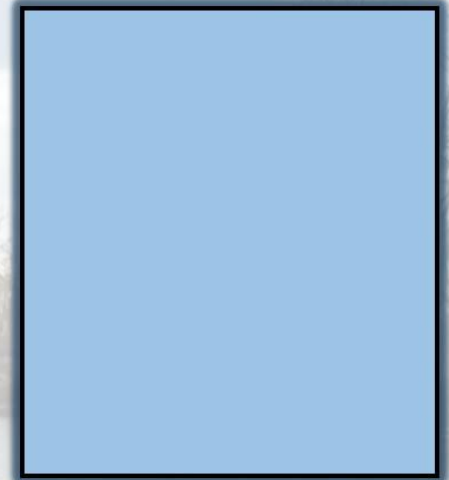
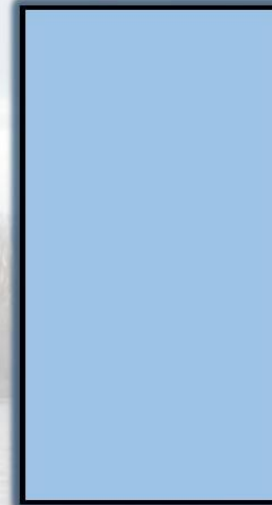
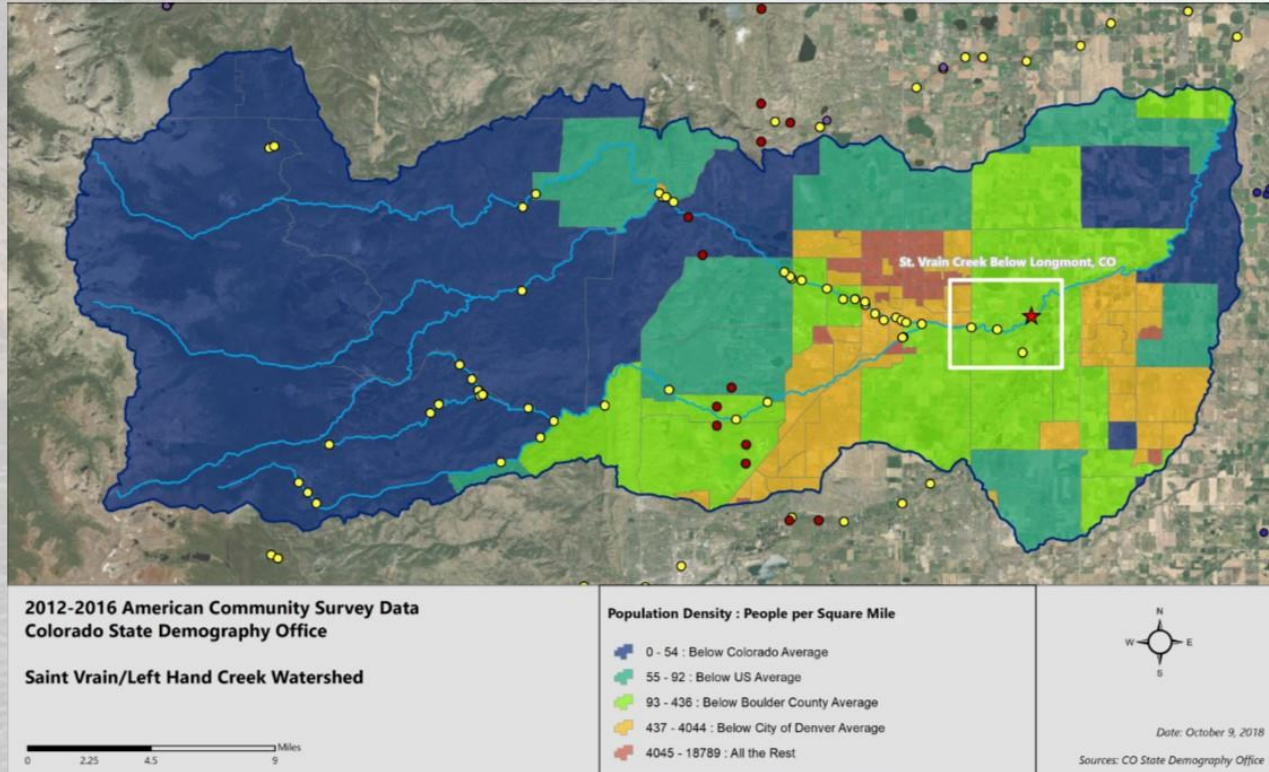
Water Quality and Water Quantity within the Saint Vrain/Left Hand Watershed
